

Northfield Academy Mobile Phone Strategy

Mobile phones remain silent and out-of-sight during all lessons.

Phone Pathway:

- 1) Everyone is **Ready** and **Safe** by handing it in to the Subject Teacher as part of our 'Meet & Greet' routine (Phone Box).
- 2) The 'End and Send' routine facilitates the collection of phones from the Phone Box.
- 3) One reminder of our values everyone makes a small mistake sometimes if there is initial reluctance.
- 4) If a phone becomes apparent during the lesson, the learner is instructed to remove it to the class Phone Box for the remainder of the period.
- 5) Further instruction results in the phone being confiscated (by the Faculty Head or SLT) and collected by the parent/carer. A SEEMiS Referral should be generated so this can be tracked/monitored.

Thereafter, the following strategies may be used (in conjunction with parents/carers):

- 6) Phone handed in at the start of school.
- 7) Phone not allowed phone in school.

Underpinning Principles

Phones are allowed in Social Spaces.

Staff must do the same and model our values/acceptable use of mobile phones.

Mobile phones cannot be charged in school.

This is **everyone's** responsibility to adopt, implement and model.
